

Description: In Kindergarten, our focus on hearing led into a study of sound, specifically how sounds are made, ways in which sounds can change, and the various ways in which scientists can study them. After learning that all sounds are made by creating vibrations, Kindergarteners completed several investigations which included “telephones”, experimenting with tuning forks to learn about pitch, and using a digital oscilloscope to watch how different sounds produce sound waves of different wavelengths and frequencies.
